

Introduction


This presentation is a brief overview of issues regarding Part 214, Subpart C, Roadway Worker Protection (RWP). This presentation focuses on the successes and future challenges as determined by the number of technical bulletins and unresolved issues that have resulted from three Technical Resolution Committees (TRC). Additionally, more than 70 items exist that have not been considered in the TRC process.

ZERO Fatalities 2004 Roadway worker fatalities – Jan. to Dec.




Note – Fatalities are only those linked to the RWP regulation. Statistics do not include other engineering employee fatalities such as bridge worker, highway accidents, crane accidents, falls from equipment, death by natural cause, etc.
