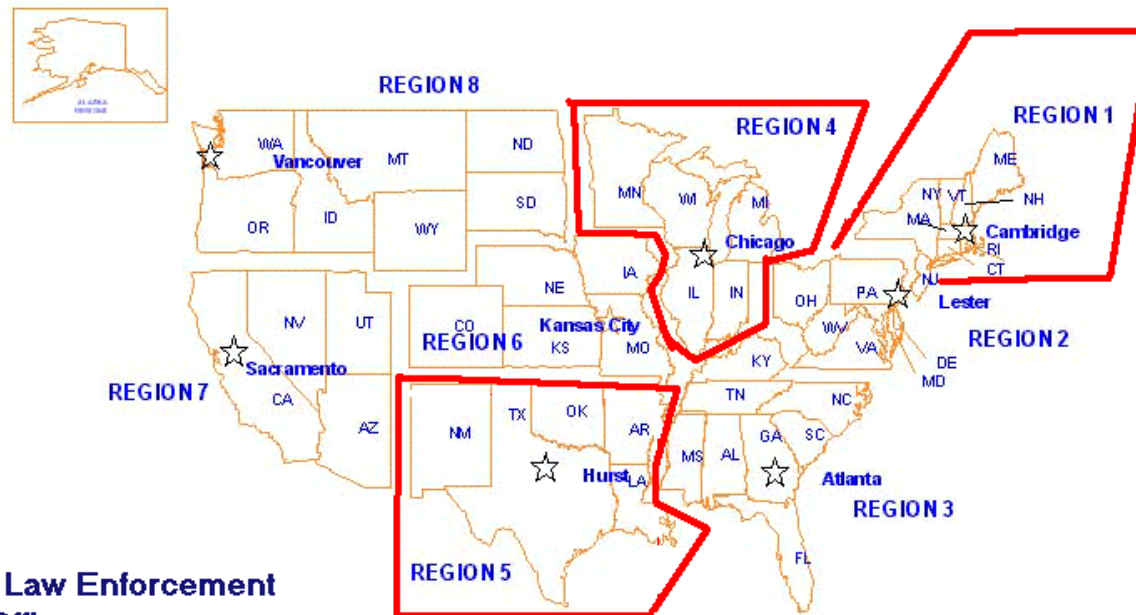

- Employees are not allowed to walk on top of a train car

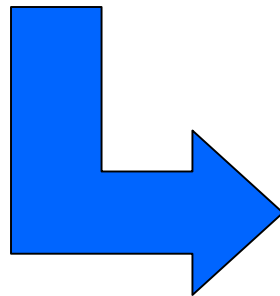
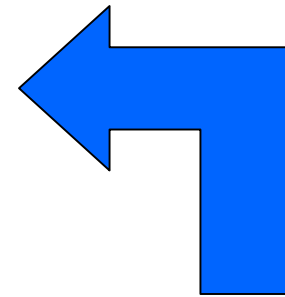
