Generally...

- Consistent with current Administration's priorities, FRA is pursuing numerous regulatory initiatives each with the safety of railroad operations as its top priority.
- Despite FRA's priorities and goals, given the Federal rulemaking process the agency has limited control over the timing of a rule's publication.

Recently Published Final Rule

- Accident/Incident Investigation Policy for Gathering Information and Consulting with Stakeholders
 - Published 10/31/24
 - Codifies existing policy statement available on FRA's website
 - As published, rule will take effect October 31, 2024



(Relatively) Recently Published Final Rules

- Dispatcher & Signal Employee Certification (5/21/24)
 - Petitions for Reconsideration Pending
- Train Crew Size Safety (4/9/24)
 - Litigation Pending
- Emergency Escape Breathing Apparatus (1/26/24)
 - Petitions for reconsideration pending
- Locomotive Recording Devices (10/12/23)



Other Priority Rules Under Development

- NPRMs
 - Automated Track Inspection (amending Part 213)
 - Procedures for waivers and safety-related proceedings
 - Positive Train Control Systems
- Final Rules
 - Passenger Equipment Safety Standards; Standards for High-Speed Trainsets (Tier III, Part 2)
 - Freight Car Certification (IIJA Mandate)



Other Rules in Process

- Training, Qualification, and Oversight for Safety-Related Railroad Employees
 - Final Rule (will incorporate existing guidance)
- Risk Reduction Program
 - SNPRM responding to Petitions for Reconsideration
- Amendments to Freight Car ReflectORIZATION
 - NPRM published July 21, 2022
 - Final rule under development (incorporating reflectORIZATION waiver)



Other Rules in Process (cont.)

- Railroad Noise Emission Compliance Regs.
 - IJA mandate
 - NPRM under development
- Accident Reporting (Part 225)
- Electronic Service Rule (Administrative Rule)



Other Rulemaking Issues of Note

- Additional Pending Petitions for Rulemaking
 - Freight Car Inspections & Role of Qualified Mechanical Inspectors (Docket FRA-2024-0084)
 - Petition to Reopen RRP Final Rule
 - Related to NAS long train study
