# Railroad Safety Advisory Committee Task Statement: Critical Incident Programs

Task No.: 09-02

**Date initially presented to the RSAC:** September 10, 2009

#### **Purpose:**

To provide advice regarding development of implementing regulations for Critical Incident Stress. Plans as required by the Rail Safety Improvement Act of 2008 (Act).

## **Description:**

- Define what a "critical incident" is that requires a response.
- Review available data, literature, and standards of practice concerning critical incident programs to
  determine appropriate action when a railroad employee is involved in or directly witnesses a critical
  incident.
- Review any evaluation studies available for existing railroad critical incident programs.
- Describe program elements appropriate for the rail environment, including those requirements set forth in the Act.
- Provide an example of a suitable plan (template).
- Assist in the preparation of a notice of proposed rulemaking (NPRM).

## **Issues requiring specific report:**

• At the discretion of the Working Group.
