

# Railroad Safety Advisory Committee Task Statement: Definition of Reportable "Train Accident"

**Task No.:** 97-7

**Date presented to the RSAC:** September 30, 1997

## **Purpose:**

To clarify criteria for calculating reportable railroad property damage, with specific focus on the calculation of damages exceeding the reporting threshold.

# **Description:**

This task requires evaluation of the concept of a reportable train accident, specifically the means by which the railroad property damage threshold is calculated (currently \$6,500). If changes in the regulations or reporting guide are deemed appropriate, specific revisions should be proposed and justified.

### **Issues requiring specific report:**

Could clarification of the means used by railroads to estimate railroad property damage improve the consistency of reporting?
